



Waitlist Policies & Expectations

Getting Started:

- We'll give you a call within 7-10 business days to chat about whether our program is a good fit for you.
- We have a waiting list, so please call us at a minimum of every 2 weeks at 613-567-5134 x9 to stay on it. If you don't, you'll lose your spot.

When a Spot Opens Up:

- It's hard to say exactly when you'll get in. Sometimes spots open up quickly, sometimes it takes longer.
- Make sure you have everything sorted out at home and work so you're ready to start right away when we call. If you can't come in within a few days, you might have to go back on the waiting list.

What to Expect:

- No vehicles, cell phones, video games, or anything else that connects to the internet are allowed.
- We're a men's only program for adults aged 20 and over.
- We follow a 12-step approach and only practice abstinence-based recovery.
- If you're taking methadone or other drug replacement medications, we'll require you to find another program or ask you to stop before you can join.
- We only accept people whose mental and physical health are stable enough to take part in our structured program.

House Rules:

- When you start, we'll give you a list of rules and responsibilities. You must know and follow them.
- Our staff will make recommendations for your addiction and any other behavioural problems you might have. You are required to follow this direction.
- We do random and selective drug tests. These are a requirement to stay in the program.
- If the staff think our program isn't right for you, you might have to leave quickly. So, it's good to have money for a ride home just in case.

Other Important Things:

- You must complete a 72-hour detox before you can join us. You can't be under the influence of drugs or alcohol when you arrive.
- You can't have any unresolved criminal charges. We do not accept clients on bail, but we do accept people on probation or parole.
- The cost of the program depends on your income. No one is turned away based on financial factors.

- We're not covered by OHIP, but if you're on ODSP or OW, you will be required to set up direct deposit to pay for your monthly program fees.
- Before you come in, let us know what medications you're taking so our Addiction Services Coordinator can review them.
